PRIMROSE

directory view page 39

Yarn: DK wool in pale yellow (A) and bright yellow (B)

METHOD

Petals Using A, cast on 8 sts.

1st row (WS) P.

2nd row K.

3rd row Bind off 4 sts knitwise, k to end. 4 sts.

4th row K4, turn, cast on 4 sts. 8 sts.

Repeat 1st–4th rows 4 times, ending with a 3rd row. 4 sts. Bind off, leaving an extra-long yarn end.

Center Using B, cast on 9 sts.

1st row (WS) P.

2nd row K1, [yo, k1] 8 times. 17 sts.

Bind off knitwise.

Making up Reverse st-st to the outside, join petals into a ring, and sew bound-off sts to first 4 cast-on sts. St-st to the outside, coil center into a tight ring and secure cast-on base. Insert center in flower and stitch in place.

LARGE LEAF

Yarn: DK wool
Needles: 2 double-pointed knitting needles

METHOD

Using 2 double-pointed needles, cast on 3 sts and make a 1¼in (4.5cm) long cord (see page 17). Continue on these sts in rows in the usual way:

1st row (RS) K1, yo, k1, yo, k1. 5 sts.

2nd row K2, p1, k2.

3rd row K2, yo, k1, yo, k2. 7 sts.

4th, 6th, 8th, 10th, 12th, and 14th rows K, working center st p1.

5th row K3, yo, k1, yo, k3. 9 sts.

7th row K4, yo, k1, yo, k4. 11 sts.

9th row K5, yo, k1, yo, k5. 13 sts.

11th row K6, yo, k1, yo, k6. 15 sts.

13th row K7, yo, k1, yo, k7. 17 sts.

15th row K17.

16th and WS rows K.

17th row Ssk, k13, k2tog. 15 sts.

19th row Ssk, k11, k2tog. 13 sts.

21st row Ssk, k9, k2tog. 11 sts.

23rd row Ssk, k7, k2tog. 9 sts.

25th row Ssk, k5, k2tog. 7 sts.

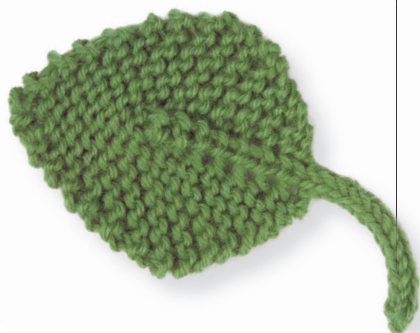
27th row Ssk, k3, k2tog. 5 sts.

29th row Ssk, k1, k2tog. 3 sts.

31st row Sk2po. Fasten off remaining st.

Specific abbreviation

sk2po—slip one knitwise, k2tog, pass slipped st over.

DOUBLE DAISY

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Yarn: DK cotton in white (A), fine cotton in white (B), and yellow (C)

METHOD

Lower petals Using A, cast on 9 sts by the cable method (see page 16).

1st row (RS) P.

2nd row K.

3rd row Bind off 5 sts purlwise, p2, turn, with yarn at back slip 1 st purlwise, bring yarn to front, p2. 4 sts.

4th row K.

5th row P.

6th row Kfb, slip these 2 sts on to left-hand needle, cast on 4 sts by cable method, p all 9 sts. Repeat 2nd–6th rows 8 times and then work 2nd and 3rd rows again. 10 petals. Bind off.

Upper petals Using B, work as lower petals.

Center Using C, cast on 5 sts by long-tail cast-on method (see page 16).

1st row (RS) Kfb, k2, kfb, k1. 7 sts.

2nd and WS rows K.

3rd row Kfb, k4, kfb, k1. 9 sts.

4th–10th rows K.

11th row K1, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k1. 7 sts.

12th row [K1, k2tog] twice, k1. 5 sts. Bind off.

Making up Join ends of each strip of petals and lightly gather inner edges of rings, leaving a space in the center. Place upper ring of petals on lower one and stitch together leaving petals free. Padding it slightly with spare yarn, set the center in place and sew on the right side with small running stitches, 1 st in from the edge. Work a few stitches across the space at the back.

SNOWDROP

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Yarn: Fine wool in white (A) and pale green (B)

METHOD

Petals Using A, cast on 4 sts.

1st row (RS) Slip 1, k3.

2nd row Slip 1, p3.

3rd row Slip 1, m1, k2, m1, k1. 6 sts.

4th row P.

5th row Slip 1, m1, k4, m1, k1. 8 sts.

Beginning with a p row, work 5 rows st-st.

11th row K2tog 4 times. 4 sts.

12th row P. Break yarn and leave sts on a spare needle. Make 2 more petals.

Base

Next row (RS) Using A, k the 4 sts of each petal. 12 sts. Beginning with a p row, work 3 rows st-st, then change to B and work 4 rows st-st. Bind off, working k2tog along row.

Stem Using B, cast on 18 sts. Bind off.

Making up Do not press. Join side seam of base. Insert stem in opening and secure.

SMALL LEAF

Yarn: DK wool
Needles: 2 double-pointed knitting needles

METHOD

Using 2 double-pointed needles, cast on 3 sts and make a 1¼in (3cm) cord (see page 17).

Continue on these sts in rows in the usual way:

1st row (RS) K1, yo, k1, yo, k1. 5 sts.

2nd and WS rows K.

3rd row K2, yo, k1, yo, k2. 7 sts.

5th row K3, yo, k1, yo, k3. 9 sts.

7th row K4, yo, k1, yo, k4. 11 sts.

9th row K5, yo, k1, yo, k5. 13 sts.

11th row Ssk, k9, k2tog. 11 sts.

13th row Ssk, k7, k2tog. 9 sts.

15th row Ssk, k5, k2tog. 7 sts.

17th row Ssk, k3, k2tog. 5 sts.

19th row Ssk, k1, k2tog. 3 sts.

21st row Sk2po. Fasten off remaining st.

Specific abbreviation

sk2po—slip one knitwise, k2tog, pass slipped st over.

ACORN

directory view page 43

Yarn: DK wool in brown (A), beige (B), and green (C)
Needles: 2 double-pointed knitting needles
Extras: Batting

METHOD

Acorn Using A, cast on 6 sts.

1st row (RS) Kfb 6 times. 12 sts.

2nd and 4th rows K.

3rd row Kfb 12 times. 24 sts.

5th row K2tog 12 times. 12 sts.

6th row K. Change to B and continue in st-st.

Beginning with a k row, work 6 rows st-st.

13th row K2tog 6 times. 6 sts.

14th row P.

15th row K2tog 3 times. 3 sts. Fasten off by taking yarn through all 3 sts.

Stem Using double-pointed needles and C, make a 2in (5cm) long 3-st cord (see page 17).

Making up Taking in 1 st from each edge, seam the acorn from the top, inserting batting and the end of the stem before closing the seam.
