As of May 1, 2009, we will begin adopting the standard of showing only the 13 digit ISBN on cover 4 and copyright pages for all trade, mass market, and audio books, as well as for cover 2 on mass market titles.

“ISBN-13” will now be identified simply as “ISBN” and will be applied, after May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009, as the standard to all of the following (ISBN-10 will be maintained for the below as long as valid):

- All catalogs and sales material.
- The copyright pages of all titles.
- Warehouse packing slips.
- Invoices and credit memos.
- Ordering via paper and phone.
- Making inquiries of our customer service department.
- Ordering via EDI.
- Electronic purchase order acknowledgements.

On the back cover of all of our titles, Macmillan has adopted the numbered barcode shown below:
